As we are in the last weeks of school please be aware of all the activities and events.

May 6th will be a half day please make arrangements for your son / daughter to get pick up at their dismissal time for a half day.

We are preparing for the new school year and need **all** payments for tuition, before and after school care, and any other outstanding **balances are to be paid in full by May 5th**. Please remember that if you plan to make **payment after May 1, the only form of payment accepted is cash, cash app, credit card, or money order** (per policy stated in student handbook on page 12). Neither your child's report card nor student records will be given or mailed out until your account is paid in full. We hope to start the new school year June 5th with all current years accounts satisfied.

Be sure if your son or daughter is not enrolled in before or after school care to make preparations for this week to have your son or daughter picked up by the half day dismissal time. Any student who is not picked up by his or her half day dismissal time will be charged a late fee according to policy stated in the student handbook. Our K5 graduation is May 17th. K5 graduation will begin at 9:00 am. We hope you will join us in this time to celebrate and recognize our graduates.
